There is no cost to pupils for Christmas Lunch as the school fund will be paying.

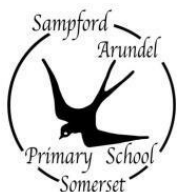

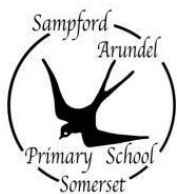

Film Event – children bring in blankets and pillows and wear red and green or Grinch related clothes.

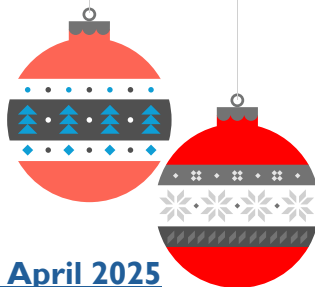

Class 2 Residential 31st March - 4th April 2025

Class 2 will be attending Kilve Outdoor Education Centre at the end of the Spring Term. The children will be involved in many activities which will cover the physical education requirements of the national curriculum that we are unable to provide in school.

This trip will be combined with Class 3 children (years 4, 5, and 6) from Stawley Primary School allowing the pupils to make new friends and memories.

The cost of the trip will be £250 per child. This has been heavily subsidised by the PE Premium. Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium will be covered by the grant the school receives to support them. A payment item is now available on ParentPay which will allow you to pay in instalments over the coming months with final payment by 28th March 2025.

We appreciate that for many families finding the money can be extremely difficult, particularly if you have more than one child involved. If the cost of the trip or the payment arrangements cause a problem, please will you speak to us about it as soon as possible. In some circumstances it is possible to arrange help with the cost. We Have been leading residential trips for many years and we are confident that there are very few problems that cannot be sorted.
